After three years, the so-called "Women's March" appears to be losing steam, while the March for Life continues to hold strong.

For decades, the National March for Life has brought Americans to Washington, DC in protest of abortion. Year after year, pro-life Americans continue to prove their concern for preborn neighbors by making the trip.

Explaining pain after abortion, Andrea echoed Dr. King, who said injustice is like a boil which must be exposed to be cured. She said, "It's like a wound that festers if left alone. It needs to be lanced, opened up so that it can be healed."
